

## **American Sign Language Interpreter**

### **Purpose:**

- Provides interpreting services to individuals throughout Greater Cincinnati who are Deaf or hard of hearing and use American Sign Language to communicate.

### **Major Duties and Expectations:**

1. Provides interpreting services to individuals who are Deaf or hard of hearing primarily by using ASL and other signed modes of communication as requested by the consumer.
2. Adheres to the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf (RID) Code of Professional Conduct (CPC).
3. Assists consumers with advocacy and education as requested.
4. Assists with distribution of satisfaction surveys to consumers.
5. Adheres to all administrative policies in accordance with stated procedures.
6. Completes required paperwork in a timely fashion.
7. Willing to be flexible with schedule changes.
8. Assists with special events, programs, and projects.
9. Complies with all accreditation standards.
10. Other duties as assigned.

### **Education/Skills/Experience:**

1. National certification (either RID or NAD at advanced or higher) is preferred. Minimum of 3 years' experience in a variety of settings including Medical, Educational, and general community venues.
2. Graduate of Interpreter Training Program with bachelor's degree preferred, or its equivalent in experience.
3. Knowledge of Deaf culture is required.

4. Excellent ASL and English skills are required.
5. Ability to interpret in medical settings required
6. Valid Driver's License and reliable transportation required.
